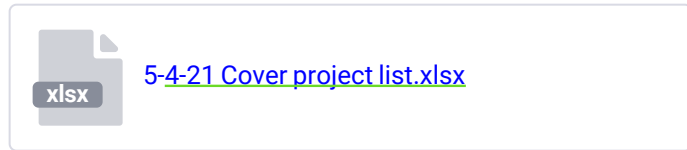
Briefly explain the topics discussed during your committee meeting
