Key Points to Remember:

Deadline to Apply is April 1st

- Travel Award applications will require a CV & letter of recommendation.
- Eligible students must be in the 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year of study.
- A statement written by the applicant (250 words maximum) describing how the applicant expects to benefit from a travel award to attend the AAAP meeting.

Interested in becoming the next AAAP Student Director???

Nomination Deadline: Monday March 17th

Each year, the AAAP solicits nominees for the position of student director on the AAAP Board of Directors. This position is for a one-year term. Student members are defined in our <u>Bylaws</u> as follows: "(f) Student Members: Persons who (1) are enrolled in a professional degree program in veterinary medicine in a school or college of veterinary medicine, or (2) are enrolled in a master's degree, doctoral degree, residency or intern program in a field related to poultry health."

All Directors including Student Directors have the following expected time commitments:

- 1. All day meeting one day before the annual meeting.
- 2.1/2 day meeting during the annual meeting.
- 3. Fall conference call meeting.
- 4. All day meeting before the IPPE meeting.
- 5. Two spring conference call meetings with committee chairs.
- 6. Multiple electronic votes and other communications throughout the year.
- 7. Virtual meetings, as necessary.

Student members are non-voting members of the board; however, they are expected to participate in all discussions and provide their input representing students.


