The AAAP Foundation is now accepting applications for student scholarships. Through the AAAP Foundation and its partners, 18 scholarships are offered each year; 5 AAAP Foundation/Merck Animal Health Veterinary Student Scholarships, 2 AAAP Foundation/Elanco Memorial Scholarships, 1 AAAP Foundation/Cobb Scholarship, and 10 AAAP Foundation Poultry Scholarships.

- Deadline to Apply is November 1st
- Scholarship Applications will require Letters of Recommendation
- Per the the AAAP Scholarship Page: "The AAAP Foundation Poultry Scholarship, the AAAP Foundation/Merck Animal Health Veterinary Student Scholarship, the AAAP Foundation/Elanco Memorial Scholarship, the AAAP Foundation/Cobb Scholarship, and the Barger/Opengart Poultry Welfare Scholarship use a Common application form". This means travels scholarships are a separate application on the AAAP website and may have differing deadlines.

Dr. James Wilson

- Dr. Wilson is a currently a 3rd Year DVM Candidate at the University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine
- Dr. Wilson also has recently completed a PhD in Poultry Nutrition and Physiology from the University of Georgia.
- Dr. Wilson is most interested the broiler and broiler breeder sectors of the poultry industry as well as the possibility of continuing in academia post veterinary school
- Over the course of his educational career, Dr. Wilson has completed many extern/internships, but one that he considered uniquely impactful was with Aviagen in Elkmont, Alabama
 - He had the unique opportunity to work with the Aviagen Veterinary Services team as a long term intern after the completion of his PhD prior to starting my DVM. For six months, he was able to get in-depth experience into the inner workings of primary breeder health and management. This allowed him to not only work in many areas throughout the company but to also conduct several research projects focused on better serving the populations of birds under his care. Lastly, he was able to work closely with an amazing team of veterinarians and form lasting friendships that he will have for years to come.
- Dr. Wilson accredits networking as a key factor in obtaining this opportunity
 - In his words: "I discovered this opportunity by attending an event for students to meet and interact with employees from several different disciplines within Aviagen. During the event I made sure to seek out the veterinarians from Aviagen, as I knew I wanted to attend vet school in the future. After meeting with Dr. Hayes I asked if they would happen to have any positions that would accommodate my unique position of an extended internship. Fortunately, Aviagen happened to be currently creating such a position, and I was able to work with an amazing team of veterinarians."
- Dr. Wilson's favorite hobby out side of school includes being outdoors whether he am fishing on the beach or out in the woods hunting.
- When asked what advice he would like to give his student colleagues Dr. Wilson stated:
 - "Gain as much experience as possible- I have worked in processing plants, with broilers, allied industry, academia, and breeders and there is still so much of this industry that is left for me to explore. And there is no better opportunity than while you are a student to be able to visit and experience these different career areas. Attend the AAAP annual meeting- While this event can be an intimidating experience, I have met so many fantastic people and made new friends by going to AAAP for the last three years."
