#### **Updated Items for this year:**

- 1. ACPV Training Program Application annual review forms were updated and now in word documents.
  - a. Each Training program fill out an Annual Review Form to update ACPV on any changes or new information the committee may need to keep the program approved. Deadlines and further information is on the forms.

## The following programs presently are in inactive or in probationary status:

### University of Pennsylvania: Status is inactive

This ACPV Training Program has not had a student in the last 9-11 years due to lack of funding. Currently the program still remains but is trying to get funding for its support. According to the Standards (#8) there must be evidence of adequate financial support, staff, and facilities, including equipment consistent with internship/residency post-DVM education. Therefore we are putting this program inactive until there is adequate funding.

#### Ohio State: Status is inactive

The original application for this training program needs to be evaluated. No Annual Review Form was received. Dr. Ziv Raviv left Ohio University. As a result this program will be in probationary status.

### **University of Cal.**—Fresno: Status is inactive

The training program at Fresno has been discontinued due to closure of CAHFS – Fresno Branch.

### **University Cal.-Davis: Status is inactive**

#### The following programs are active and up to date on their requirements:

NC State University- The program is a 24 month degree program offering a non-thesis Masters of Specialty Veterinary Medicine (MSpVM). 3 students enrolled in 2012 including Annika Hoffman (graduated in June 2012 and applied to ACPV exam in 2012), Jocelyn Romano and Tak Niino (starting at end of June 2012). Kabel Robbins graduated from the program in 2011 applied and passed ACPV Exam. The program is meeting all criteria for ACPV training program. Program is active and up-to-date.

Cal. Animal Health & Food Safety Lab System – Tulare and Turlock- The program is a 24 month program offering a degree in Avian Diagnostics and Production Medicine. The CAHFS

is composed of a central reference lab located in Davis and branch laboratories in Turlock, Tulare and San Bernardino. Faculty from Fresno are now part of CAHFS – Tulare. They are keeping the training programs at both Tulare & Turlock in case an avian resident applies to the Tulare branch. They currently have one student enrolled, Dr. Daylene Mills. Dr. Julie Kelly graduated in 2012. No student applied or took the ACPV exam in 2011. The program is meeting all criteria for ACPV training program. Program is active and up-to-date.

University of Georgia - The program is an 18 month degree program offering a non-thesis Masters of Avian Medicine (MAM). There are 5 current students enrolled in the program. 2 students will be finishing in December 2012 (Anne Hurley Bacon and Blayne Mozisek). 3 students, Chad Malinak, Elisa Meyers, and Yun-Ting Wang, began the program in summer of 2012. 2 students (William "Drew" Parker, Natalie Armour) from this program applied and passed the ACPV exam in 2011. 3 students finished December 2011 (Denise Brinson, Peter O'Kane and Rodrigo Espinosa) and applied for the ACPV exam in 2012. The program is meeting all criteria for ACPV training program. Program is active and up-to-date.

Miss. State University- One student Josh Standridge graduated in 2011. Student went to private practice and did not applied to take the ACPV exam. There are no current students at this time. In April 2012 Dr. Tim Cummings left MSU to work in the allied industry. They have also revamped their program to allow post veterinary graduates from other universities to enter their program. They will still continue their dual degree program with students enrolled at MSU-CVM. The program is meeting all criteria for ACPV training program. Program is active and up-to-date.

Master of Avian Health and Medicine Online Degree - University of Georgia and University of Melbourne (AU) – The program offer a three year Master of Avian Health and Medicine (MAHM). There are 5 current students enrolled in the program Akos Klaus, Allan Ball, Jafar Pazani, Christiaan Ter Veen and Erry Setyawan. 9 students graduted in 2011 (Elena Behnke, Katherine Hayes, Philip Hammond, Brian Burke, Branislav Karajonji, Merlijn Kense, Nirman Minhas, Yuen Phang and Benjamin Wood). One student Elena Behnke applied for the ACPV exam in 2012. The program is meeting all criteria for ACPV training program. Program is active and up-to-date

In accordance with the proposal adopted by the board per Dr. Tim Cummings in Jan. 1999, the nine active programs have been reviewed by a committee member. Five programs have been found to be in compliance for the year 2012. Three programs are inactive and one program is in probationary status. The review documents have been placed in a file for each program and are held by the committee chair.
