

## 2015 ACPV Training Program Review

### Updated Items for this year:

- 1.- NCSU has a student in a 4 year joint program (Poultry/Pathology) they would like to clarify the ACPV eligibility.
- 2.- UGA - Dr. C. Stephen Roney was hired
- 3.- MSU – In September 2014, Dr Sue Ann Hubbard left for MSU for a job in the allied industry. In March 2015, Drs. Natalie Armour and Marha Pulido joined MSU as full time faculty.
- 4.- MAHM - The University of Georgia will offer this degree program without the University of Melbourne starting August 2015

### The following programs are active:

#### **1. NC State University (NCSU)**

The program is a 24 month degree program offering a non-thesis Master of Specialized Veterinary Medicine (MSPVM). Three students were enrolled in 2015—including Dr. Christina Lindsey (graduated in June 2015), Dr. Seiche Genger (started June 2014 and Dr. Rebecca Jones (will start at end of 2015). Dr. Tak Nino graduated from the program in 2014. Two students in 2014 successfully applied for the ACPV exam. Two students passed all sections of the exam a of the ACPV Exam. The program is meeting all criteria for an ACPV training program. Program is active and up-to-date.

#### **2. University of California (California Animal Health & Food Safety Lab System—CAHFS)**

The program is a 24 month program offering a Master of Avian Diagnostics and Production Medicine. The CAHFS is composed of a central reference lab located in Davis and branch laboratories in Turlock, Tulare and San Bernardino. 75% of the curriculum is spent in CAHFS case-related activity. 25% of the curriculum is available for investigative activities, conferences, and seminars. No students were enrolled, graduated or took the ACPV exam so performance is N/A. One student is enrolled this year, Dr. Silvia Carnaccini. The program is active with proper funding and is meeting all criteria for an ACPV training program.

#### **3. University of Georgia (UGA)**

The program is an 18 month degree program offering a non-thesis Masters of Avian Medicine (MAM). A new faculty member Dr. C. Stephen Roney was hired. Five students are currently enrolled in the program. Three students will be finishing the program in December 2015 (Alexis Kiers, Samantha Pohl). Three students graduated from this program in December 2014 (Dr. Thomas “TJ” Gaydos, Dr. Elizabeth Dale, and Dr. Sarah Tilley). Two students recently began the program in June 2015 (Dr. Tyler Gamble and Dr. Dulmelis Sandu) Three students successfully applied for the ACPV exam in 2014. Two students passed all 3 sections of the exam, one student did not pass 1 of the 3 sections of the exam. The program is meeting all criteria for an ACPV training program. Program is active and up-to-date.

#### **4. Mississippi State University (MSU)**

The program offers a Veterinary Science Masters with a specialty in poultry medicine. This program is based from the Poultry Research & Diagnostic Laboratory in Pearl, MS. Courses are taught from PRDL as well as some on campus courses at MSU College of Veterinary Medicine in Starkville, MS. The program takes both post DVM students from other universities as well as dual degree students from within MSU CVM. There are currently 3 students enrolled (Dr. William Dillard, Dr. Shelby Harris, and Dr. Steven Hutter). No students graduated on 2014. . They have 3 resident, 5 affiliated and one faculty sitting for exam in 2015. Two new faculty members have been hired upon the exit of one faculty member in 2014. The

program is meeting all criteria for an approved ACPV training program. The program is active. Student funding, performance and review could be more clearly defined in the future.

#### **5. Master of Avian Health and Medicine (Online Degree) - University of Georgia and University of Melbourne (UGA-UM)**

The three-year program offers a Master of Avian Health and Medicine. This is an online program in conjunction with the University of Georgia and University of Melbourne (however University of Georgia will offer this degree program without University of Melbourne starting August 2015), allowing educational opportunities in poultry medicine. There are currently 7 students enrolled with a total of 9 students previously graduating the program. In 2014, one student applied for the ACPV exam and passed. No student applied for ACPV exam on 2015. No changes have been made to the program over the past year. The program is meeting all criteria for an approved ACPV training program. The program is active. Student performance and review could be more clearly defined in the future

#### **6. The Ohio State University Poultry Health**

The program offers a Masters in Avian Medicine. They have 2 resident and 1 affiliated faculty members. There are currently 4 students enrolled. They had three students graduated in 2014, and no students sit for the ACPV in 2014. The program is meeting all criteria for an approved ACPV training program. The program is active. Student funding, performance and review could be more clearly defined in the future.

#### **7. Purdue University**

The program offers a Master's degree in avian medicine. They have 3 resident and 1 affiliated faculty members. There are currently 2 students enrolled (Dr. Yuko Sato, Dr. Geoff Lossie). New funding was received for this program. The program is meeting all criteria for an approved ACPV training program. The program is active. Student performance and review could be more clearly defined in the future.

#### **8. University of Pennsylvania**

The ACPV training program has been establishing funds to support a student every 2 years. Funds are acquired and Dr. Nancy Ting is enrolled with a start date of August 2014. The program is expected to have funding for one student every 2 years. The program is active and meets all requirements. Program duration, curriculum structure and performance review isn't clearly defined in the form and should be evaluated in more detail in the future

#### **Review Summary**

In accordance with the proposal adopted by the board per Dr. Tim Cummings in Jan. 1999, eight programs have been reviewed by the ACPV Training Program Review Committee. Eight programs have been found to be in compliance for the year 2014-2015. The review documents have been placed in a file for each program and are held by the committee chair.
