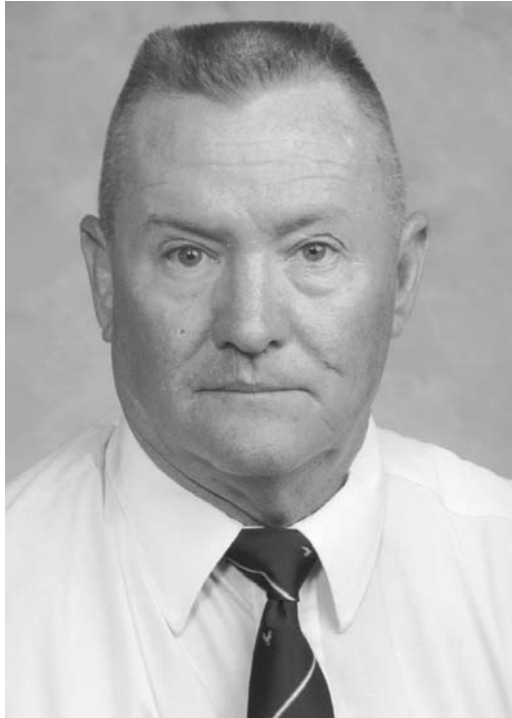


OBITUARY

Dr. Robert Kenny Page



Dr. Robert Kenny Page, 63, of Winder, Georgia, died Tuesday, December 23, 2003. Survivors include his wife, Pat P. Page, two daughters, Sally Rogers and Susan Steele, a son, Bobby, and eight grandchildren.

Dr. Page received his D.V.M. from the University of Georgia in 1964, and an M.S. in 1966. He was employed as a technical service veterinarian by Eli Lilly and Company from 1966–67, and joined the faculty of the University of Georgia as an assistant professor in 1967. He was promoted to associate professor in 1976 and to professor in 1981, where he served until his retirement from the university in 1998. He led an active retirement as a broiler grower and as a frequent consultant to poultry companies.

Kenny was a highly respected and capable poultry veterinarian, who was in demand for his expertise and judgment in poultry production and disease diagnosis and control. He taught avian medicine to veterinary students during his entire tenure at the University of Georgia and was a mentor to a generation of veterinarians in the UGA Master of Avian Medicine program.

Kenny Page was a good friend, respected colleague, and will be missed.
